
Here's a modern refrigerator that features the sleek vertical screen integrated into the freezer door. The screen displays the real-time temperature of both the freezer and the fridge.

The water dispenser on the fridge door delivers chilled water with the press of a lever. Here is the cradle where the glass can rest while waiting for the chilled water. The door handle makes it easy to open the door and access the food and beverages inside. As you open you'll see the reservoir that stores the water. There are compartments where bottles and other useful items can be placed. Inside the fridge, there are main shelves near the cooling elements. This feature keeps the food cooler than the items that are reserved (or stored) in the bins on the fridge door. Vegetables and fruits can be kept in the crisper drawers below the fridge to stay fresh all the time.

If we look at the freezer, we'll see two compartments on the door and inside the freezer (or it). This part of the refrigerator allows you to freeze some foods of your choice. But don't forget when you want to prepare food, let the frozen items thaw before you start cooking. This is an ice tray with a storage bin. Whenever you need a glass of cool water in the hot seasons, just add an ice cube. That's all about the features of this refrigerator (informal speech). Thanks for watching.



Different sentence structures:



I will be working on my project.

They'll be waiting for the but when I arrive.

This structure is used to talk about interrupted actions or actions in progress, something that you will not be doing again, for making polite inquiries, for present actions that will continue, and for making assumptions about what is happening in the present.

More examples:

I will be teaching for twenty sessions in this institute.

I won't be inviting him to my house ever again as he was so rude today.

Will you be inviting anyone to the thanksgiving?

She will still be watching movies with her friend.

If he is not responding, he will be driving.

The structure is formed with a subject, followed by 'will + be + verb-ing', and the rest of the sentence.

Never forget to make it question form, only reversing the subject and the word "will" works.
