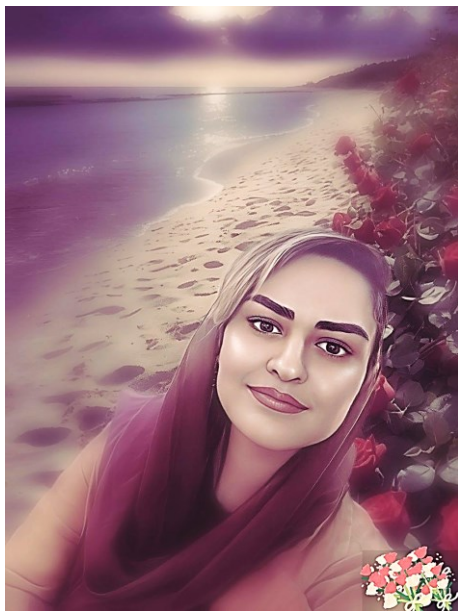

To + simple
verb

I really want to try on the white blazer to see how it looks.



It is used to explain the reason
or purpose for an action

I am going to turn on the TV to watch documentaries.

Her friends are heading to the library to borrow some novels.

To + verb tells us the purpose of the action. The verb must be simple. Sometimes the infinitive of purpose completes the structures.

More examples:

I went to the mall **to buy** a new bag.

She opened the door **to let** the dog out.

Our teachers explain the lessons several times **to be** sure that we get the information perfectly.
